



### ANTIDOTE AND FIRST AID TREATMENT

Atropine is antidotal for **GUARDIAN 9015** Insecticide poisoning. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY IN ALL CASES OF SUSPECTED POISONING.

**INTERNAL:** If the material has been swallowed induce vomiting immediately. This may be done by introducing a finger into the throat or by giving warm salt water. One (1) tablespoonful of salt to a glass of water). Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**EXTERNAL:** If the material has been spilled on the skin, immediately remove the patient from the vicinity of the insecticide, remove all contaminated clothing, and wash skin with soap and water. If the material gets into eyes, wash immediately with running water for at least ten minutes.

### NOTICE

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin or eyes. Do not get on skin or in eyes. Do not breathe fumes.

Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles when handling the concentrate to prepare oil solutions. Keep all unprotected persons out of operational area. ### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**OUTDOOR FOGGING:** For use as an outdoor fog for reduction of flies, mosquitoes, and certain other types of flying insects. **Guardian 9015** is for use in standard fogging equipment which handles oil base insecticides. Use 2 gallon per acre.

**Fogging Machine Setting:** Hold blotter for 5 seconds in fog 10 to 20 feet from nozzle. Blotter should be barely wet. If too wet, damage may occur to foliage, glass windows, etc. If too dry, less effective insect kill may result.

**INDOOR FOGGING:** For control of flies, mosquitoes, wasps, gnats, fruit flies and certain other flying insects in food processing plants, industrial plants, theaters, warehouses.

**TO BE APPLIED BY PEST CONTROL OPERATORS ONLY.** Apply when plants are not in operation. Building should not be occupied during fogging operation. Cover all food processing equipment while fogging and thoroughly clean after each operation. DO NOT use in edible products area of food processing plants. Ventilate before reoccupying.

**Mist Spraying:** Remove birds, pets, fish bowls from area to be treated. For control of flies, mosquitoes, wasps, gnats, etc. Direct spray behind refrigerators, cabinets, boxes, machinery where pests hide. Then place spray applicator to give complete dispersion of spray mist throughout area being treated. Close room for about 15 minutes after treatment. Use a mist blower.

**CAUTION:** This product is toxic to fish. Keep Out of Any Body of Water. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

**Wet Spraying Indoors.** For control of flies, mosquitoes, wasps, gnats, German cockroaches, ants, silverfish, spiders and ticks, use 9015. Apply as a course spray to baseboards, closets, cracks, etc., where insects hide. To control ticks treat as a wet spray to animal sleeping quarters. Treat thoroughly around windows, and doors. Repeat as necessary. Do not apply to areas which will be contacted frequently by children.

DO NOT use in edible products areas of food processing plants.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**OUTDOOR FOGGING:** For control of house flies and mosquitoes, fog with **Guardian 9015** in a well-ventilated area. Use equipment which handles 1/2 pint per hour.

**Fogging Machine Setting:** Fogger should be held 10 to 20 feet from nozzle and fog should be evenly wet. Do not wet damage may result. Do not fog windows etc. If fogging is less effective, repeat fogging may result.

**INDOOR FOGGING:** For control of house flies and mosquitoes, fog with **Guardian 9015** in a well-ventilated area. Use equipment which handles 1/2 pint per hour.

**TO BE APPLIED BY PEST CONTROL OPERATORS ONLY.** Apply when plants are not in bloom. Plants should not be sprayed during bloom period. Do not fog in areas where people are present while fogging and do not fog in areas where people are present. DO NOT use in areas where people are present during rains. Do not fog in areas where people are present.
