DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Proper dosages of this product will control growth of algae and effectively kill many bacteria which may cause infection.

FOR USE AS A SHOCK TREATMENT

The purpose of this product is to provide a shock treatment to pools that are unacceptable for use due to the presence of bacteria or algae, or discolored because of neglect or the presence of minerals such as iron or manganese. One pound of this product will impart 9 ppm (parts per million) of available chlorine to 9,800 gallons of water. In some cases when the extent of organics present in the pool does not allow the water to respond to the initial dose, a second treatment may be necessary.

1. Remove as much as possible any floating, suspended and/or sunken matter that may be present by use of a hand skimmer, pool leaf rake or by vacuuming to waste.
2. Adjust pool water pH to 7.2-7.8.
3. Introduce this product at the rate of 1 lb. per 9,800 gallons of water.

Allow water to run continuously during treatment. An empty spa or front of pump if suction is impeded. Also, there may be a risk of clog due to the accumulation of dead algae. Backwash occurs. Repeat dosage on the second day if necessary. Improvement on the third day, consult your dealer or the manufacturer for further advice. Do not resume regular pool until chlorine residual falls to between 1 and 3 ppm. Pools may be allowed to enter the pool until chlorine residual falls to 2.0.

NOTE ON POOLS TREATED FOR ALGAE: If this product is used on superchlorinated algae infested pool, after treatment it is to brush the walls and floor to expose algae that may be in wrinkles that might protect algae from high chlorine residual.

FOR USE IN DAILY CHLORINATION

INITIAL DOSAGE: Add 1 ounce of this product for each 11 water. The initial chlorination dose should be repeated until residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm is obtained.

MAINTENANCE DOSAGE: Add one ounce per 5,800 gallons needed to maintain a residual of 0.6 ppm to 1.0 ppm of available chlorine. During hot sunny days or when bathing load water frequently as available chlorine may dissipate rapidly. Chlorine residual between 0.6 ppm and 1.0 ppm at all times.

One ounce of this product will add 1.0 ppm available chlorine to 5,800 gallons of water. During hot sunny days or when bathing load water frequently as available chlorine may dissipate rapidly. Chlorine residual between 0.6 ppm and 1.0 ppm at all times.

Application should be made using one of the following methods:
SKIMMER: Use this method to avoid bleaching vinyl liner or slimmer of all chemicals and/or debris. Make sure that filter water is properly recirculating through slimmer. Remove a that may be in an in-line automatic chemical dispensing product slowly into slimmer, making sure that the material the system at the same rate. DISE DIRECTLY INTO POOL: Broadcast dosage across surface. prevent liner damage, use slimmer method above.
