DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Adjust pool water pH to 7.2 - 7.6. For pools with copper plumbing best pH factor is 7.6 to 7.8.
2. If pool has not been previously stabilized with Stabilizer and Conditioner (cyanuric acid) add the correct dosage. Follow the directions for use on the label for that product.
3. Fill chlorinator with tablets. The rate of solution of the tablets depends upon the volume of water flowing through the chlorinator. Keep chlorine residual in pool above 1.0 p.p.m. at all times.
4. Adjust valves on chlorinator so that water flow can be observed passing through. Keep chlorine residuals between 1 and 2 p.p.m. by increasing or decreasing flow with proper valve settings.

Please note: The pH of No. 10 Slow Dissolving Tablets is on the acid side and will tend to reduce the pH and alkalinity of the pool water. Proper pH should be maintained by periodic additions of sodium carbonate or sodium bicarbonate.

To determine pool capacity: Rectangular pools: Length times width times average depth in feet times 7.5 equals gallons. Round or oval pools: Average diameter times average diameter times depth in feet times 3.14 equals gallons. (One cubic foot of water equals 7.5 gallons.)

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, do not inhale dust or fumes. Flush and pour with large amounts of water. Do not reenter container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material remaining. Do not reuse container or dispose in approved ground area or body of water.
