#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

**Initial Dose:** 1 gallon Algaecide to 50,000 gallons of water.

**Maintenance Dose:** 1 quart Algaecide to 10,000 gallons of water.

Initial dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, the initial dose should be repeated within 10 days. After the algae growth is removed from the pool.

Maintenance dose should be added at least once every 7 days. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

If makeup water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1 quart of Algaecide for each 10,000 gallons of fresh makeup water added per week.

When the swimming season is over, add 1 gallon of Algaecide to 50,000 gallons of water in treating water left in pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

#### ACTIVE INGREDIENTS

n-Alkyl (60% C<sub>12</sub>, 30% C<sub>14</sub>, 5% C<sub>16</sub>, 5% C<sub>18</sub>)  
Dimethyl Benzylammonium Chloride 18.4%  
Dialkyl (60% C<sub>12</sub>, 30% C<sub>14</sub>, 5% C<sub>16</sub>, 5% C<sub>18</sub>)  
Methyl Benzylammonium chlorides 1.6%

When this Algaecide is used as directed, it will kill and prevent development of *Chlorella Pyrenoidosa* (Green), *Phormidium Inundatum* (Black Algae), *Phormidium Retzii* (Square D Algae), *Chroococcoides* (Blue Green), and other swimming pool algae.

This Algaecide is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals but should not be mixed with soap and other cleaners or pre-mixed with other water-treating chemicals. The Algaecide will react when added to water containing chlorine.

#### WARNING

##### Harmful if swallowed

Algaecide is a concentrate. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Causes severe eye irritation. Causes skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, skin or on clothing. In case of contact wash with soap and plenty of water. For eyes get medical attention.
