#### Conditions


1. Add the following to the Directions for Use statement : "Reentry into treated swimming pools is prohibited above levels of 4 ppm of chlorine."
2. The ingredient statement must be shown to total 100%.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. ### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

When this product is used as directed, it will control and inhibit the development of *Chlorella Pyrenoidosa* (Green), *Phoridium Inundatum* (Black algae), *Phoridium Retzii* (Square D Algae), *Lynoba Veriscolor* (Blue-Green) and other swimming pool algae. This product is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals, but should not be mixed with soap and other cleaners or premixed with other water-treating chemicals. This product works best when added by itself to pool water.

**INITIAL DOSE:** 1 gallon of this product to 50,000 gallons of water.

**MAINTENANCE DOSE:** 1 quart of this product to 50,000 gallons of water.

Initial dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, the initial dose should be repeated within 48 hours after algae debris is removed from the pool. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added at least once every 7 days. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

If makeup water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1 quart of this product for each 10,000 gallons of fresh makeup water added per week.

When swimming season is over, add 1 gallon of this product to 50,000 gallons of water in treating water left in pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clean water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it. Securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
