When this product is used as directed, it will control and inhibit the development of Oxforella Pyrenoidosa (Green), Phoridium Inumdatum (Black algae), Phoridium Retzii (Square O Algae), Lynoba Veriscolor (Blue-Green) and other swimming pool algae. This product is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals, but should not be mixed with soap and other cleaners or premixed with other watertreating chemicals. This product works best when added by itself to pool water.

INITIAL DOSE: I gallon of this product to 50,000 gallons of water.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: 1 quart of this product to 50,000 gallens of water.

Initial dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, the initial dose should be repeated. within 48 hours after aloae debris is removed. from the pool. When pool is free of visible alone. use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added at least once every 7 days; If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.
