

DIRECTIONS

1. Adjust water pH to 7.2 - 7.6. For pools with copper plumbing best pH factor is 7.6 - 7.8.
2. Add Nu-Clo conditioner and stabilizer s-triazinetriol (cyanuric acid) at the rate of 3 pounds for every 10,000 gallons of pool water. At this rate add sufficient conditioner according to total gallonage of pool.
3. Secure chlorinator in the area of pool that is agitated by return flow from filter. If residual remains too high, chlorinator should be moved further from the agitated area which will slow the dissolving action of the tablets.
4. First week: Add 2 tablets per 5,000 gallons of pool water. Thereafter add 1 tablet per 5,000 gallons per week or as needed to maintain chlorine residual between 1.0 and 3.0 at all times. Please note: The pH of Nu-Clo slow dissolving chlorine tablets is on the alkaline side and will tend to reduce the pH and alkalinity of the pool water. Proper pH should be maintained by periodic additions of sodium carbonate or sodium bicarbonate.
To determine pool capacity: Rectangular pools - length times width times average depth (in feet) times 7.5 equals gallons. Round and oval pools - average diameter times average diameter times depth (in feet) times 5.9 equals gallons. One cubic foot of water equals 7.5 gallons.
