The submission referred to above, sent in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to update the product labeling, has been reviewed by the Agency and found to be acceptable provided that you make the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended label.

1. Delete the comparison claims "✓ Most economical" and "✓ 5 times normal strength" from the labeling as per the Agency letter dated June 22, 1994, enclosed for your reference.
2. Reword the phrase "✓ Kill: 6ozs. per 10,000 gallons" to read "✓ Initial Dose: 6ozs. per 10,000 gallons".
3. Reword the phrase "✓ Prevent: 1-1/2 ozs. per 10,000 gallons" to read "✓ Maintenance Dose: 1-1/2 ozs. per 10,000 gallons".
4. In the Precautionary Statements section, revise the sentence "Corrosive, causes eye damage and skin irritation." to read "Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage.".
5. To the Precautionary Statements add the sentence, "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.".
6. In the Precautionary Statements section, move the sentence "Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it." to the "Disposal" section.

7. Revise the header "Practical Treatment (First Aid):" to read "Statement of Practical Treatment". The words "First Aid" are not required and may be incorporated at your own discretion.

8. Under the Statement of Practical Treatment replace the sentence "If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water." with "If swallowed, drink promptly large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting.".

Your release for shipment of the NU-CLO ALGAESTROY product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the product labeling is enclosed for your records. Submit one (1) copy of the revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**DANGER:** Keep out of reach of children. Corrosive, causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

**PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID):** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucousal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is in violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

When this algaecide is used as directed, it will control and inhibit the development of *Chlorella Pyrenoidosa* (Green), *Phormidium Inundatum* (Black Algae), *Phormidium Retzii* (Square D Algae), *Lynoba Versicolor* (Blue-Green) and other swimming pool algae. This algaecide is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals but should not be mixed with soap or other cleaners or premixed with other water treating chemicals. This algaecide works best when added by itself to pool water.

**Initial Dose:** 6 Ounces of this algaecide to 10,000 gallons of water.

**Maintenance Dose:** 1-1/2 ounces of this algaecide to 10,000 gallons of water. Initial dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, the initial dose should be repeated within 48 hours after algae debris is removed from the pool. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose. Maintenance dose should be

added at least once every 7 days. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently. If makeup water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1-1/2 ounces of this algaecide for each 10,000 gallons of fresh makeup water added per week. When swimming season is over, add 6 ounces of this algaecide to each 10,000 gallons left in pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop spills with clean water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly. Securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. #2025
