These granules are the most highly concentrated stabilized cy developed to establish an initial chlorine residual through sun an proper levels of available chlorine through normal d granules are easy to dispense and 100% soluble.

DIRECTIONS FOR DAILY USE

It is in violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner not labeled.

INITIAL DOSAGE: When starting up a new pool, submerge demand and to establish an available chlorine residual of 1.0 ounces of these granules per 1,000 gallons which will provide chlorine. Test with a reliable chlorine test kit.

The next morning add Conditioner and Stabilizer (cyanuric acid) according to the directions on the label. Bathers should not be in the pool until the chlorine residual has dropped to 3 ppm or less.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: Add 1/4 to 1/2 ounce per 1,000 gal chlorine residual at six times of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm, as determined should be maintained in the range of 1.2-7.8.

SHOCK TREATMENT: A shock treatment should be made every 3 to 4 days after heavy rains. Less frequent shock treatments may be needed. Add 1-1 1/2 ounces per 1,000 gallons. Bathers should not be in the pool until chlorine residual has dropped to 3 ppm or less.

NOTE: that daily dosages should vary to compensate for loss and dirt caused by storms or heavy bather loads. Additions to maintain a chlorine residual of 1.0-1.5 ppm.

Applications should be made using one of the following methods:
SKIMMER METHOD: Use this method to avoid bleaching swimmer or other chemicals and/or debris. Make sure that it properly recirculating through skimmer. Remove any chemical automatic chemical dispensing device. Pour these granules making sure that the material is drawn into the system at the material to accumulate as gases generated may cause an **DOSE DIRECTLY INTO POOL:** Broadcast dosage across surface. Do not damage. Use skimmer method above.

DIRECTIONS FOR INDUSTRIAL USE

This product is used to control the growth of bacteria, and commercial and industrial water cooling towers. Prior to use in cooling towers, systems should be cleaned to remove slimes, and other deposits.

When starting with fresh cooling tower water, submerge demand and to establish a chlorine residual of 1.0 ppm to 1.5-1.7 ppm of these granules per 1,000 gallons which will provide chlorine. Test with a reliable chlorine test kit. The next morning add the product to the system to maintain the water.

These granules should be added daily or as needed at the towers of water to maintain a chlorine residual at an level determined by a suitable test kit. The pH should be maintained. Proper dosage should be broadcast over surface of water cooling tower water. Do not mix in a pan. A shock treatment during hot weather or after heavy rains. Less frequent during cool weather. For the shock treatment, add 1-1/2 ounces of water which will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine. Flexibility must be maintained in the event of heavy accumulation by storms or heavy use which require additional dosage chlorine residual between 1.0 ppm and 1.5 ppm.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE AS A CONTACT A THIS PRODUCT WILL BLEACH VINYL OR PAINT. In use product will amaze you with its speedy action. Shut off and settle down. Do not reactivate pump for 6 hours.
