### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT

#### HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION** Keep out of reach of children. Causes eye damage. May cause skin sensitization in certain individuals. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**FIRST AID:** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call physician immediately.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment authority. **STORAGE:** Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly. Securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is in violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**INITIAL DOSE:** 10 ounces of this product to 10,000 gallons of water.

**MAINTENANCE DOSE:** 5 ounces of this product to 10,000 gallons of water. Initial dose should be used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, the initial dose should be repeated within 48 hours after algae debris is removed from the pool. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose. Maintenance dose should be added at least once every 7 days.

**ONE TIME APPLICATION:** This product works best when added to a freshly cleaned pool. This product should be used at a rate of one gallon to every 11,000 gallons of pool water.

Empty skimmer of all chemicals and/or debris. Remove any chemicals that may be in an in-line automatic chemical dispensing device. Make sure that the filter is on and that water is properly recirculating through skimmer. Pour this product slowly into skimmer, making sure that the liquid is drawn into the system at the same rate as it is being poured.

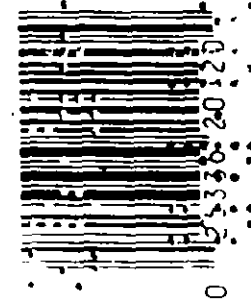
