

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DANGER: Highly Irritative. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothes. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

FIRST AID (PRACTICAL TREATMENT):

1. This product is a powerful chlorine gas. Do not open container indoors. Hold away from face when opening to avoid breathing fumes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

Proper dosages of this product will control growth of algae and effectively bacteria which may cause infection.

FOR USE AS A SHOCK TREATMENT

The purpose of this product is to provide a shock treatment to pool unacceptable for use due to the presence of bacteria or algae or direct cause of neglect for the presence of minerals such as iron, or manganese. (of this product will impart 9 ppm to 10 ppm per million) or available chlorine gallons of water. In some cases where the extent of organics present in the pool show the need to respond to the initial dose, a second treatment may be necessary.

1. Remove as much as possible any floating, suspended and / or sunken items may be present by use of a hand skimmer, pool net rake or by vacuuming.

2. Adjust pool water pH to 7.2-7.5.

3. Introduce this product at the rate of 1 lb. per 1,000 gallons of water.

SEE DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATIONS BELOW:

Allow filter to run continuously being careful to empty the filter basket pump if suction is "rocking". Also, there may be a tendency for the filter to the accumulation of dead algae. Backwash filter if this occurs. Repeat the second day if necessary. If there is no improvement on the third day, your dealer or the manufacturer of this product for further advice. Do a regular chlorine dosages until chlorine residual is between 1.0 and 1.5. Bathing should not be allowed to enter the pool until chlorine residual is 1.0 or less.

NOTE ON POOLS TREATED FOR ALGAE: If this product is used to shock superchlorinate an algae infested pool, after treatment it is important that the walls and floor to expose algae that may be in cracks or wrinkles to protect algae from high chlorine residuals.

FOR USE IN DAILY CHLORINATION

INITIAL DOSAGE: Add 1 ounce of this product for each 1,000 gallons of initial chlorination dose should be repeated until a chlorine residual of 0.5 p.p.m. is obtained.

MAINTENANCE DOSAGE: Add one ounce per 5,000 gallons daily or to maintain a residual of 0.5 p.p.m. to 1.0 p.p.m. of available chlorine as determined by a chlorine test kit. Keep pH in range between 7.2-7.6.

One ounce of this product will add 1.0 p.p.m. available chlorine to 5,000 water. During hot sunlit days or when bathing load is heavy, test water as available chlorine may dissipate rapidly. Maintain chlorine residual of 0.5 p.p.m. and 1.0 p.p.m. at all times.

Applications should be made using one of the following methods:

SKIMMER: Use this method to avoid bleaching vinyl liner or paint. Empty of all chemicals and / or debris. Make sure that filter is on and that water recirculating through skimmer. Remove any chemicals that may be in automatic chemical dispensing device. Pour product slowly into skimmer sure that the material is drawn into the system at the same rate. Do not material to accumulate as gases generated may cause an explosion. **DOSE DIRECTLY INTO POOL:** Broadcast dosage across surface to prevent liner damage, use skimmer method above.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep product in dry tightly closed container when not in use. Cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container the water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash in approved landfill area.

EMERGENCY HANDLING: In case of contamination or decomposition, container. If possible isolate container in open and well-ventilated area large volumes of water.
