HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION: Keep out of reach of children. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. May cause skin sensitization. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Liquid Winterizer 7 works best when added to a freshly cleaned pool. Liquid Winterizer 7 should be used at the rate of one quart for every 10,000 gallons of pool water.

Empty skimmer of all chemicals and/or debris. Remove any chemicals that may be in an in-line automatic chemical dispensing device. Make sure that filter is on and that water is properly recirculating through skimmer. Pour Liquid Winterizer 7 slowly into skimmer, making sure that the liquid is drawn into the system at the same rate. Keep filter on for 2-3 hours to assure good distribution.

If equipment has been shut down for the season, fill clean pail with at least 4 gallons of fresh water and stir in no more than 1 gallon of Liquid Winterizer 7. Pour resulting dilution into pool while walking around the perimeter. Repeat until pool is properly dosed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Map up spills with clean water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly. Securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
