

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
DANGER. Corrosive. Causes eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. May cause burns to broken skin. Wear goggles or face shield and protective clothing when handling. Wash hands after handling.

FIRST AID (PRACTICAL TREATMENT): If swallowed feed gruel, cooked cereal or bread soaked in milk to dilute. If on or in cooking oil, in case of personal contact, remove excess material and flush skin or eyes with cold water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes get medical attention as soon as possible. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Strong oxidizing agent. Do not use in or near pump, vents or containers with moisture, dirt, organic matter or other chemicals or any foreign matter. May start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases and possible generation of fire.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds or public waters. Permits may be required for discharges containing this product into public waters. For a complete statement of the Environmental Protection Agency.

SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS (PLEASE READ)

1. This product has a powerful chlorine odor. Hold away from face when opening to avoid breathing fumes.
2. Prolonged contact between this product and undissolved state and with surfaces or painted surfaces will result in bleaching of the white paint. Introduce this product through the summer or in a pressurized feeder to avoid direct contact with other paint.
3. When adding this product to a summer or feeder make sure there are no other chemicals present as a violent reaction may occur. This is a very dangerous to mix chemicals.
4. Use this product as directed as per instructions on label. Do not take advice from others or experiment by yourself.
5. If this product is used to shock or super chlorinate a pool, after treatment it is important to brush walls and floor to expose algae that may be in cracks or wrinkles that might protect algae from high chlorine residual. Such protected algae will begin to reproduce again when high chlorine residual falls.
6. This product because of its potent formulation can be dangerous if not used properly. Do not mix with any other chemicals. This could result in a violent chemical reaction. Do not add water to this product in a closed container. Do not add this product to a small amount of water in a pan. When adding this product to a summer make sure pump is on and water is circulating so that material is drawn into circulation system. Do not allow build up of dry material in summer as gases generated may cause an explosion.

DIRECT:
 It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a pool with a pH of 7.2 or below. The pH must be maintained between 7.2 and 7.8. If the pH has not been previously tested, follow the instructions for use on the label for 3. Set the chlorinator in the area of the pool that remains for 10% of the chlorinator should be in the water. The chlorinator should be in the water. In newly filled pools follow steps 1 through 4. Set the chlorinator to maintain a residual of 1.0 ppm at all times as determined by a test kit. Then add 1 tablet per 7,500 gallons per week or as needed. Test the pH at night as determined by a test kit. If the pH is below 7.2, add 1/2 lb. of 66% dry acid to the pool. If the pH is above 7.8, add 1/2 lb. of 10% sodium carbonate to the pool. Test the pH and adjust as needed.

STORE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from moisture. Isolate containers in open area if possible. Do not reuse empty containers. Rinse empty containers thoroughly before reusing. Place in trash collection.
