Dear Mr. Visconti:

The Agency has reviewed your submission in accordance with continuing registration under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, and determined the action to be acceptable with the following conditions:

- Revise the marketing claim "Disinfects, kills algae and bacteria" to read "Kills algae".
- Move the Precautionary Statements for Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section underneath the First Aid statements directly above the Environmental Hazards.
- Under Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals, change "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco" to "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."
- Under the three Directions for Use headings revise the subheading to read "It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling".
- Under Directions for Swimming Pool change "Pool should not be entered until the chlorine residual is below 3.0 ppm" to read "Reentry into treated swimming pools is prohibited above levels of 3 ppm of chlorine".
- In accordance with PR Notice 2007-4 revise the Storage and Disposal instructions as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in original container, tightly closed away from heat or open flame. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated place. Keep container off wet floors. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not put spilled product, filled or partially filled containers in the trash. In case of decomposition, isolate container in open area if possible and flood with large amounts of water. Dispose of waste material according to label use directions otherwise call 1-800-CLEANUP for guidance from your local solid waste agency.


• Under CONTAINER DISPOSAL change 3/4 full to 1/4 full.

UNSTABILIZED POOLS: Follow steps 1 and 2 and then add two (2) tablets per 7,500 gallons of pool water to establish a chlorine residual of 1.0-1.5 ppm as determined by test kit. Repeat volume of water flowing through the chlorine residual above 1 ppm at all dosages as needed to maintain a residual of 1.0-1.5 ppm at all times. Thereafter, add 1 tablet per 7,500 gallons per week or as needed to maintain chlorine residual of 1.0-1.5 ppm.

STABILIZED POOLS: Follow step 1 and then add 1 tablet per 7,500 gallons per week or as needed to maintain a chlorine residual of 1.0-1.5 ppm at all times as determined by a test kit. Maintain some flexibility in dosing your pool as chlorine demand will vary depending upon thunder storms and pool exposure.

Shock your pool weekly during hot weather and less frequently in cooler periods according to instructions provided with the chosen product. Application should be made using one of the following methods:

FLOATING CHLORINATOR: Load floating chlorinator with prescribed dosage as per instructions on that chlorinator. Allow chlorinator to float freely in pool. Increase chlorination by increasing dosage or by securing chlorinator in a highly agitated area of the pool. Decrease chlorination by decreasing dosage or by securing chlorinator in an area of less

SKIMMER METHOD: Empty the skimmer of all chemicals and/or debris. Place prescribed dosage into skimmer basket. Length of filtration cycle will influence the rate at which the Repeat this procedure two more times. Offer for recycling, if available, or discard in trash.

IN-LINE EROSION CHLORINATOR: Load prescribed dosage into chlorinator according to instructions supplied with the chlorinator. Adjust the chlorinator control valves to always maintain the desired chlorine residual.

It is in violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. These tablets will help your pool stay clean and algae free through the winter months when the pool is covered and the recirculation and filtration system is off. This product should be applied as the last step prior to covering the pool.

1. Adjust water pH to 7.2-7.6 as determined by a test kit. For goods with copper plumbing best pH factor is 7.6-7.8.

2. Use Winter Tablets at the rate of 1 lb. (2-8 oz. tablets) per 5,000 gallons of water. This will provide 21 ppm of available chloring during the winter storage months to help control the growth of algae and bacteria.

A Slow dissolving microbiocide, algaecide and disinfectant for the reduction and elimination of algal slime, bacteria and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water cooling towers and decorative fountains.

These tablets contain a high concentration of chlorine which may be dangerous if not applied

1. Adjust water pH to 7.2-7.8.

2. If the water has not been previously stabilized with cyanuric acid add the correct dosage. Follow the directions for use on the label for that product.

3. Fill chlorinator with tablets. The rate at which the tablets dissolve depends upon the

4.Adjust valves on chlorinator so that water flow can be observed passing through, Keep chlorine residuals between 1 and 2 ppm by increasing or decreasing flow with proper valve

PLEASE NOTE: The pH of these tablets is on the acid side and will tend to reduce the pH and factors such as air and water temperature, bather load, frequency and intensity of rain or alkalinity of pool water. Proper pH should be maintained at 7.2-7.6 as determined by a test kit through periodic additions of sodium carbonate or sodium bicarbonate.

Each tablet weighs 227 grams or 8.0 ounces.

Store in cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flowe. In case of decomposition isolate container in open area if possible and flood with large amounts of

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 3/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for latter use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip.
