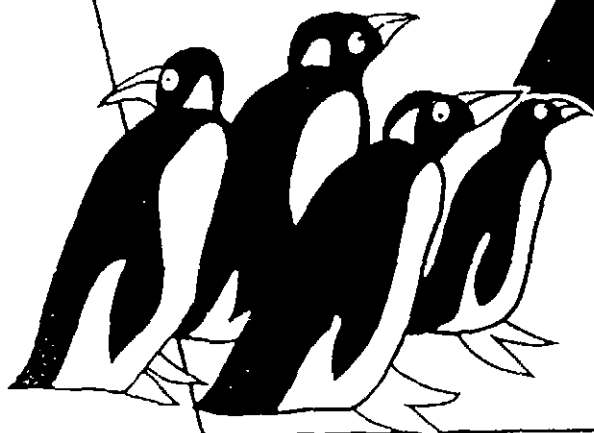

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

## HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**DANGER:** Keep out of reach of children. Corrosive, cause severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For ingestion, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly large quantity of egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

When this product is used as directed, it will control and inhibit the development of Chloroella Pyrenoidosa (Green), Phormidium Inundatum (Black algae), Phormidium Retzii (Square D. Algae), Lyngbya Veriscolor (Blue Green) and other swimming pool algae. This product is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals

but should not be mixed with soap and other cleaners or premixed with other water-treating chemicals. This product works best when added by itself to pool water. This product at use dilution is non-corrosive to inanimate surfaces.

**INITIAL DOSE:** 2 gallons of this product to 50,000 gallons of water.

**MAINTENANCE DOSE:** 2 quarts of this product to 50,000 gallons of water.

Initial dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, treat with initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or reappear, repeat this treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added at 3-5 day intervals. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently. If makeup water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 2 quarts of this product for each 10,000 gallons of fresh makeup water added per week. When swimming season is over, add 2 gallons of this product to 50,000 gallons of water in treating water left in pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clean water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly. Securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
