- Revision to First Aid Statement in accordance with PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

1. Add the following to the Directions for Use statement: "Reentry into treated swimming pools is prohibited above levels of 4 ppm of chlorine."
2. The ingredient statement must be shown to total 100%.

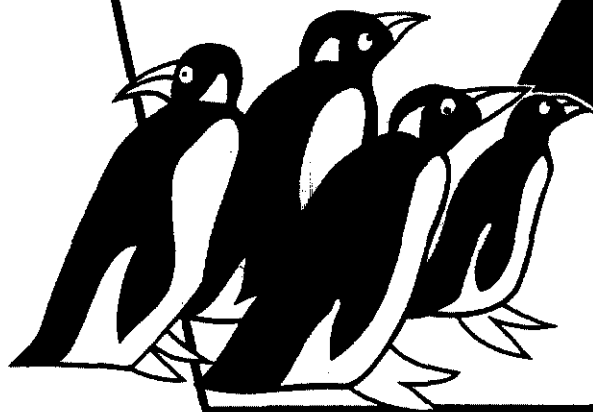

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Keep out of reach of children. Corrosive, cause severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

FIRST AID:

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

When this product is used as directed, it will control and inhibit the development of *Chlorella Pyrenoidosa* (Green), *Phormidium incurvatum* (Black algae), *Phormidium Retzii* (Square D Algae), *Lynoba Veriscolor* (Blue-Green) and other swimming pool algae. This product is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals, but should not be mixed with soap and other cleaners or premixed with other water-treating chemicals. This product works best when added by itself to pool water. This product at use dilution is non-corrosive to inanimate surfaces.

INITIAL DOSE: 2 gallons of this product to 50,000 gallons of water.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: 2 quarts of this product to 50,000 gallons of water.

Initial dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, treat with initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or reappear, repeat this treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added at 3-5 day intervals. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently. If makeup water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 2 quarts of this product for each 10,000 gallons of fresh makeup water added per week.

When swimming season is over, add 2 gallons of this product to 50,000 gallons of water in treating water left in pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clean water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly. Securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
