Your Amended Application Dated June 6, 2000

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Three copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

- a. With respect to the "First Aid" statements, if you have a 1-800 #, please add it to the first aid section for emergency medical treatment information. The subheading, i.e., If Swallowed, If On Skin, etc., should be in bold letters, and displayed as recommended in PR Notice 20003.
- b. Under the product name "NuClo Poly 60" delete "and other algae species". All species must be specified
- c. The preferred location of the ingredient statement is immediately below the product name, followed by the Keep Out of Reach of Children statement and signal word, and the first aid statement. Refer to attached labeling format.
- d. The sum of percentage of the active and other ingredients must be 100%. The term "100%" should be expressed as part of the ingredient statement.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

FIRST AID: Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Poly 60 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools. This product is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals but should not be mixed with soap or other cleaners or premixed with other water treating chemicals. This product works best when added by itself to pool water. For maximum effectiveness pools containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using product. For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 11 to 17 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 11 to 17 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. To maintain pools free of visible algae growth subsequent additions of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment.

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This product can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of these chemicals normally required. However, do not mix this product with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on the site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Plastic: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.


