The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Poly[oxyethylene (dimethyliminio) ethylene-(dimethyliminio) ethylene dichloride] RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** yet being reregistered under section 4(g) of FIFRA.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed. HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

FIRST AID:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Poly 60 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools. This product is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals but must not be mixed with soap or other cleaners or premixed with other water treating chemicals. This product works best when added by itself to pool water. For maximum effectiveness pools containing heavy growth of algae must be cleaned prior to using product. For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 11 to 17 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. To maintain pools free of visible algae growth subsequent additions of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water must be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment.

Reentry into treated swimming pools is prohibited above levels of 4 ppm of chlorine. This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This product can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of these chemicals normally required. However, do not mix this product with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

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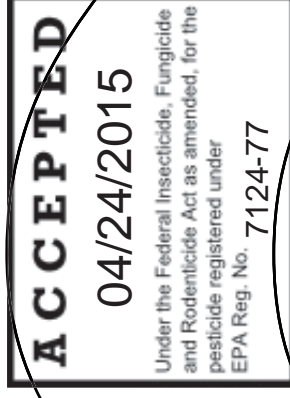

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers must be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clear water. All pesticides must be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on the site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying.

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 3/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds.

Pour rinse into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinse for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Offer for recycling, if available, or discard in trash.
