

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. The purpose of this product is to provide a shock treatment to pools that are unacceptable for use due to the presence of algae or decalcified water because of neglect, or the presence of such minerals as iron or manganese. TO AVOID POSSIBLE BLEACHING OR DISCOLORATION OF VINYL LINERS AND ALL CHEMICALS THROUGH SKIMMER, NEVER TWO AT ONCE, AS A VIOLENT REACTION MAY OCCUR.

1. Remove as much as possible any floating, suspended and/or bottom matter that may present by use of a hand skimmer, net, or vacuuming to waste.
2. Adjust pool water pH to 7.2 to 7.6.
3. Start filter and add Vinyl Pool Shock at the rate of 1 lb. (16 oz.) per 7,500 gallons of pool water. Do so by feeding Vinyl Pool Shock through the skimmer. Allow filter to run continuously, being careful to empty strainer basket in front of pump if suction is impeded. Also, there may be a tendency for the filter to clog due to the accumulation of dead algae. Backwash filter if this occurs. Repeat dosage on the second day if necessary. If there is no improvement on the third day consult your dealer or the manufacturer of this product for further advice. Do not resume regular chlorine dosages until readings read between 1 and 3 ppm.

BATHING SHOULD NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE POOL UNTIL THE CHLORINE RESIDUAL DROPS TO 3 PPM OR LESS.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition isolate container in open area if possible, and flood with large amounts of water. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area.

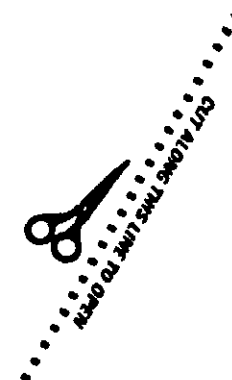
