In a freshly cleaned and filled spa or hot tub, add initially 2 to 4 fluid ounces of Sparkle Spa & Hot Tub Algaecide per 500 gallons of water. Subsequent additions should be made at 2 to 4 fluid ounces of Sparkle Spa & Hot Tub Algaecide per 500 gallons of water every 7 to 10 days after initial treatment for maintenance.
