NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.


Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statement of Formulation (CSF) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

This product is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs and decorative fountains containing heavy growth of algae must be cleaned prior to using this product.

To treat visible algae growth: Add an initial dose of 36.5 to 56 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

After cleaning and fresh water fill: Add initially 20 to 36.5 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water.

Maintenance: Subsequent additions of 6.5 to 13 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water must be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.
