

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an fluid ounces of NUCLO POLY 30 ALGAECIDE. move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of pool add initially 12.8 to 22.5 fluid ounces of NUCLO POLY 30 ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons of water.
