**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND
DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DANGER: Keep out of reach of children. Corrosive, causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes call physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or the Regional office of the EPA.

When ALGAECIDE 25 is used as directed, it will control and inhibit the development of *Chlorella Pyrenoidosa* (Green) *Phoridium Inundatum* (Blue-green), *Phoridium Retzii* (Square D Algae), *Lynoba Versicolor* (Blue-green) and other swimming pool algae.

ALGAECIDE 25 is compatible with most commonly-used swimming pool chemicals but should not be mixed with soap or other cleaners or pre-mixed with other water-treating chemicals. ALGAECIDE 25 works best when added by itself to pool water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use his product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

INITIAL DOSE: 12 ounces of ALGAECIDE 25 to 10,000 gallons of water.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: 3 Ounces of ALGAECIDE 25 to 10,000 gallons of water.

Initial dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, the initial dose should be repeated within 48 hours after algae debris is removed from the pool. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added at least once every 7 days. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

If make-up water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 3 ounces of ALGAECIDE 25 for 10,000 gallons of fresh make-up water added per week.

When swimming season is over add 12 ounces of ALGAECIDE 25 to each 10,000 gallons left in pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clean water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly. Securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
