The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted with comments.

Proposed Amendment:

Update the Storage and Disposal Statement in compliance with PR Notice 2007-4 for NuClo Borate Extreme (EPA Reg.#: 7124-109).

General Comment:

Based on the review of the material submitted (submission of September 22, 2010), to update the "Storage and Disposal" statement is acceptable with comments. The following comments apply:

Page 2. Revise the "**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**" statement as per EPA regulations, 40 CFR 156.140, 40 CFR 156.144, 40 CFR 156.146, and 40 CFR 156.156 and summarized in PR Notice 2007-4 of October 29, 2007 (Revised: April 29, 2008) as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment.

A. Insert and add under [Subheading.] **Pesticide Storage:...** In case of spill, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding this container in trash.


B. Insert and add under [Subheading] **Pesticide Disposal:....** State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the EPA Regional Hazardous Waste Representative.

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with comments is enclosed. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

DANGER. CORROSIVE: Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Wear protective eye wear, goggles, face shield, or safety glasses. This product is designed to improve water quality by reducing algae growth and improving filtration. Use of this product maintains sparkling, clear water, improves sanitizer effectiveness and reduces eye and skin irritation.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Initial Application:

Use 2 pounds of this product per 1,000 gallons of water. Broadcast half the dose (1 lb. per 1,000 gallons) while walking around the perimeter of the pool. Add the other half 10 minutes later. Make sure pump is running when adding. This product will raise the pH. Add 3/4 pound of pH Decreaser for every pound of this product added. Filter for at least four hours and adjust the pH if needed to 7.2-7.8 with a reliable test kit. This product is compatible with all swimming pool chemicals. Maintain sanitizer levels indicated on the sanitizer label. This product should be tested at least every month and maintained at 30-50 ppm. The concentration of this product is decreased by only backwash or water loss from splash out.

Winterizing:

This product will help maintain clear and clean water throughout the winter months. Maintain 30-50 ppm before winterizing to enhance your winter chemicals.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in original container, tightly closed away from heat or open flame. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated place. Keep container off wet floors. → INSERT → IN CASE OF SPILL...

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not put spilled product, filled or partially filled containers in the trash. In case of decomposition, isolate container in open area if possible and flood with large amounts of water. Dispose of waste material according to label use directions otherwise call 1-800-CLEANUP for guidance from your local solid waste agency. → INSERT → STATE PESTICIDE OR ENVIRONMENTAL

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Offer for recycling, if available, or discard in trash.
