2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 7135-7."
 - b. Revise the label to indicate the significance of the word "Plus" in the product name. The word could be misleading since it could imply that the product is more effective than products of similar composition. If the "Plus" refers to the fact that the product contains a water repellent, this should be indicated by a statement such as "Contains wood preservative plus water repellent." Otherwise, delete the word "Plus."

Allow a minimum of 24 hours drying time prior to painting treated wood.
