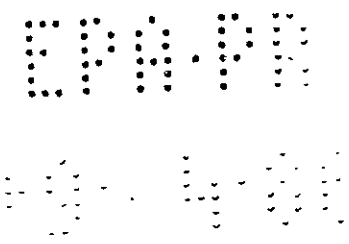

Directions: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Protective clothing, goggles and rubber gloves should be worn when applying Wood Protectant Plus or when handling freshly treated lumber. Apply by brushing or dipping. Immerse wood to be treated for at least 3 minutes per inch of thickness, if dipping is impossible, apply two liberal coats by brush, allowing a minimum of one hour between applications. Allow a minimum of 24 hours drying time prior to painting treated wood. For lumber to be used under severe conditions of exposure as in steps, a longer soaking period and heavier absorption is recommended.

May injure living plants during application. Cover plants to prevent direct contact. Do not apply over painted or varnished surfaces. Do not apply on wood intended for food, feed, potable water, livestock or dairy animal contact surfaces.

Sunnyside Wood Protectant Plus offers positive protection to lumber and millwork from damage by moisture, termites, decay, mold, mildew and staining and decay (rot) fungi. It protects siding, outdoor furniture, patios, decks, fences, etc. Wood Protectant Plus penetrates into the wood and will not crack, blister or peel. It is an excellent primer for paint, varnish, stain or enamel. Caulking compounds and wood putty adhere better and last longer when applied to raw wood treated first with Wood Protectant Plus.
