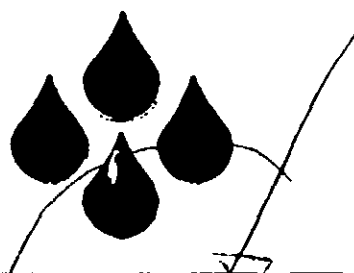

Sunnyside Green Formula Wood Preservative protects and preserves wood, both above and below ground, against mold, mildew, rot, wood destroying fungi, mildew stain and attack by termites. It effectively protects shingles, docks, piers, fence posts, pilings, staking material, decks, spars, and house siding.

It will tint most woods a green color that will slowly fade depending on weather and sunlight exposure. Redwood will darken to almost a black color which will not fade. Not intended as a stain. Green color will bleed through light shades of paint.

Directions for use: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Protective clothing, goggles, and rubber gloves should be worn when applying this product and when handling freshly treated materials. Posts, pilings, and other heavy wooden members should be well seasoned and soaked for 12 to 48 hours. Lumber should be thoroughly saturated by low pressure spray, roller dip, or brush application and air dried before use. Coverage will range, depending on porosity of wood and method of application, from 100 to 300 sq.ft. per gallon. This product is not for use indoors except for barns and out buildings. Do not use on wood intended for food, feed, potable water, livestock or dairy animal contact surfaces. Clean up tools and application equipment with mineral spirits.

NOTE TO USER: Do not apply to painted, varnished or previously finished surfaces. Do not apply over bark. May injure plants and vegetation. Cover to protect from contact during application.
KEEP FROM FREEZING.

Storage: Product will freeze. Store at temperatures between 40°F. and 100°F. If the product has been spilled or is leaking, remove the source of the spill or leak. Recover free liquid. Spread absorbent, then pick up and place in containers. Then, where applicable, wash area with detergent and water. Store product in the original container only. Keep container closed when not in use.

Disposal: Do not use empty container. Wrap container and put into trash collection.
