

## SWIMMING POOL TREATMENT

### INITIAL DOSE

Apply Pearl White concentrated Bleach at the rate of 12 ounces to 15,000 gallons of pool water. Repeat until a 1.0 ppm chlorine residual is obtained.

### ROUTINE TREATMENT

Use a test kit to insure a residual chlorine content of from 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. Repeat above dosing daily or as needed to maintain 0.6 to 1.0 residual by frequent testing.

Keep the pH of the pool water in the 7.2 to 7.6 range as determined with a test kit.

**NOTICE** - Strength of solution degrades with age. Use a test kit and increase dosage as necessary to obtain required level of available chlorine.

### ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS

This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.
