  - d. Include the following additional subheadings:

Pesticide Disposal

Add these heading to the Storage and Disposal section.

2. A release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

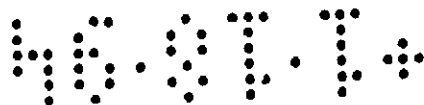

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Algi-See controls the growth of microscopic plants called algae which thrive in warm, sunlit pools. It is algae that turns the water green and produces odors that make swimming unpleasant. This condition is controlled by the addition of Algi-See at periodic intervals throughout the swimming season to prevent algae from growing. It is important to note that small amounts of Algi-See added at regular intervals will do a better job for algae prevention control than large amounts added only where algae has become a nuisance.

**REGULAR CARE:** To maintain water clarity and freshness, and control algae slime, use the following dosages in the chart below.

POOL CAPACITY	INITIAL DOSE	MAINTENANCE DOSE
2,000 gal.	5 1/2 oz.	1 1/2 oz.
5,000 gal.	13 oz.	3 3/4 oz.
10,000 gal.	26 oz.	6 3/4 oz.

Use proportional amounts of Algi-See for other pool gallonage amounts. Use initial dose when filling the pool at the beginning of swimming season. If visible algae is present after initial application, vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae is still present or should reappear, repeat treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, proceed to use maintenance doses at 3 to 5 day intervals. During hot, sunny weather, or heavy bather loads, more frequent additions may be necessary. Add Algi-See directly to pool. Never mix chemicals together.
