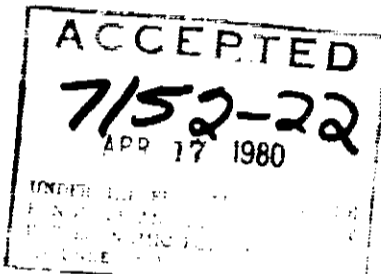

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR NEWLY FILLED POOLS

1. USE ONE "DAY-TAB" to add 1.0 ppm of chlorine to pool water to adjust the pH. 2. For a 1.0 ppm of SEABOARD Stabilized DAY-Tabs per 10,000 gallons should be added to open circulation system and establish a residual chlorine level of .5 ppm. If necessary, the dosage can be increased. Then "DAY-TABS" should be added according to directions for daily maintenance. Swimming should not be permitted until the chlorine residual is at least .5 ppm.

DAILY MAINTENANCE

1. Add "DAY-TABS" to the pool water daily. 2. The chlorine level should be maintained between 1.0 and 1.5 ppm. 3. The pH level should be maintained between 7.2 and 7.6. 4. Never permit children or animals to drink pool water. 5. Never permit children or animals to swim in pool water.
