DANGER

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ALGI-CIDE is an outstanding algae growth depressant in all types and sizes of pools. It helps eliminate and prevent odors from confined water. **ALGI-CIDE** is fully compatible with the usual water treatment chemicals. By controlling algae growth with **ALGI-CIDE** the chlorine demand by the pool water may be reduced. **ALGI-CIDE** is non-corrosive to rubber or metal parts.

Initial Application: To a cleaned pool add one gallon to 25,000 gallons of water, or ratio thereof.

Maintenance Dose: Use one quart per 25,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

Booster Dose: Immediately after every rain add one quart per 25,000 gallons of water as above.

Important: Follow above directions without fail, even when pool is not used. Algae growth must be fought at all times.
