STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store product in a cool, dry area, away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid deterioration. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in newspaper and discard in trash.

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals.

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Harmful if inhaled. This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms.

Algi-Cide Liquid controls the growth of microscopic plants called algae which thrive in warm, sunlit pools. It is algae that turns the water green and produces odors that make swimming unpleasant. This condition is controlled by the addition of Algi-Cide at periodic intervals throughout the swimming season to prevent algae from growing. It is important to note that small amounts of Algi-Cide added at regular intervals will do a better job for algae prevention control than large amounts added only when algae has become a nuisance.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

Ensure all equipment is working properly. Backwash the filter system following manufacturer's directions. Adjust pH between 7.2 – 7.6. Check for metals and if present, add stain and scale inhibitor to prevent staining of pool surface due to metals.

Initial Dose: Add 1 gallon of Algi-Cide per 25,000 gallons of water. Add the product directly into the pool by pouring around the entire outside perimeter of pool. Allow filter to run for at least six (6) hours after adding product. During this period, swimmers are not allowed into the water.

If algae growth is visible, apply initial dose. Then vacuum after 24 hours to remove dead algae. If algae is still visible, repeat dose as necessary until pool is free of visible algae.

Maintenance Dose: Add 1 quart of Algi-Cide to 10,000 gallons of water every 3-5 days or as needed. Allow filter to run 30 minutes after adding product. During this period, swimmers are not allowed into the water.

Booster Application: Apply 1 quart per 10,000 gallons of water during prolonged rainfall or heavy bather loads. Allow the filter to run 30 minutes after adding product. During this period, swimmers are not allowed into the water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store this product in a cool dry area, away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid deterioration.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
