Dear Ms. Bjomson:

The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

- To revise your CSF to add additional suppliers (See CSF dated 5/11/05)
- To update "First Aid" statement in accordance with PR Notice 2001-1
- To update the "Precautionary Statements"
- To update the "Storage and Disposal" statement

Conditions

1. Revise the "Precautionary Statements" to read:

"Corrosive: Cause irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe dust or spray mists. Irritating to nose and throat. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, protective clothing and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

2. Include the following re-entry statement: "Reentry into treated pools is prohibited above levels of 3 ppm due to risk of bodily injury.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals.

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear safety glasses or goggles and protective gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Avoid breathing vapors. Vacate poorly ventilated areas as soon as possible. Do not return until strong odors has dissipated.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public water unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water board or regional Office of the EPA.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT: Mix only with water according to label directions. Mixing this product with chemicals (e.g. ammonia, acids, detergents, etc.) or organic matter (e.g. urine, feces etc.) will release chlorine gas which is irritation to eyes, lungs and mucous membranes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **Precaution: Never add directly into pool as it will bleach the liner or painted surface.**

DIRECTIONS FOR NEWLY FILLED POOLS

MINI-TABS are added directly to skimmer at the rate of one pound per 8000 gallons to establish a residual chlorine value of 1.0 – 1.5 ppm. This dosage should be repeated until the test results for residual chlorine are in the range of 1.0 – 1.5 ppm. Sun-Screen protection and stabilization of chlorine in the pool is provided by stabilizer according to label directions.

REGULAR MAINTENANCE TREATMENT

Adjust whatever proportioning mechanism that might be used to assure a constant treatment level of 1.0 – 2.0 ppm available chlorine in the pool water (normally 1- 2 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons daily). The chlorine level should be checked daily with the use of a suitable test kit. Due to the daily changes in weather, temperature, and bather load, the frequency and the amount of MINI-TABS added will vary. Pool water pH must be adjusted and maintained in the pH range of 7.2 – 7.8. For each pound of MINI-TABS, a half pound of SEABOARD PLUS is added for pH control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

Pesticide Storage: Store this product in a cool dry area, away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid deterioration.

Pesticide Disposal: In case of spill, flood areas with large quantities of water. Product or rinsates that cannot be used should be diluted with water before disposal in a sanitary sewer.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse empty container but place in trash collection.
