The amendment (label update and revised CSF) referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following labeling changes below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

a. Revise the referral statement to read: See back panel for additional precautionary statements.

b. Delete the word: First Aid.

c. Include the following additional subheadings:

Container Disposal
Pesticide Disposal

Add these heading to the Storage and Disposal section.

d. Delete the word: prevent

e. Based on the CSF, the following statement must be added:

Physical or Chemical Hazards
Do not use or store near heat or open flame

2. A release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
3. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
4. Our records have been adjusted to reflect your product name change:

OLD PRODUCT NAME: Super AlgiSea

NEW PRODUCT NAME: Super Algi-Sea

5. The submitted Confidential Statement of Formula (dated January 7, 1994) is acceptable. Note also that this confidential will supersede all previous confidentials.

However note for future reference that the upper certified limit (Block 14a) should be around 51.5% and the lower certified limit (Block 14b) should be around 48.5% for this product.

When Super Algi-Sea is used as directed it will kill and prevent pyrendoisa (green algae), Phormidium retzii (square C algae), Lyngbya (blue-green algae) and other swimming pool algae.

Super Algi-Sea is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals. Super Algi-Sea should not be mixed with other water-treating chemicals. Super Algi-Sea should be added to pool water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label. **INITIAL DOSE:** Add 5-1/4 oz. of Super Algi-Sea to 10,000 gallons of pool water. **MAINTENANCE DOSE:** Add 1-1/2 oz. of Super Algi-Sea to 10,000 gallons of pool water. Use proportionate amounts of Super Algi-Sea for other pool sizes. Use initial dose when filling the pool at the beginning of the season. Repeat application if visible algae growth after initial application, vacuum pool after 24 hours. Repeat application if visible algae is still present or should reappear, repeat treatment. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance intervals. During hot, sunny weather or heavy bather loads, more frequent applications may be necessary.

If makeup water is added at more than 10% per week of pool water, add Super Algi-Sea for each 10,000 gallons of fresh makeup water. Add Super Algi-Sea directly to pool water. Never mix pool chemicals together.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive, Harmful. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Use face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of food.
