





Ensure all equipment is working properly. Backwash the filter system following manufacturer's directions. Adjust pH between 7.2 – 7.6. Check for metals and if present, add stain and scale inhibitor to prevent staining of pool surface due to metals.

Initial Dose: Add 5 ¼ oz of Super Algi-Sea per 10,000 gallons of water. Add the product directly into the pool by pouring around the entire outside perimeter of pool. Allow filter to run for at least six (6) hours after adding product. During this period, swimmers are not allowed into the water.

If algae growth is visible, apply initial dose. Then vacuum after 24 hours to remove dead algae. If algae is still visible, repeat dose as necessary until pool is free of visible algae.

Maintenance Dose: Add 1 ½ ounces of Super Algi-Sea per 10,000 gallons of water every 3-5 days or as needed. Allow filter to run 30 minutes after adding product. During this period, swimmers are not allowed into the water.

Booster Application: Apply 1 ½ quart per 10,000 gallons of water during prolonged rainfall or heavy bather loads. Allow the filter to run 30 minutes after adding product. During this period, swimmers are not allowed into the water.
