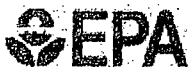

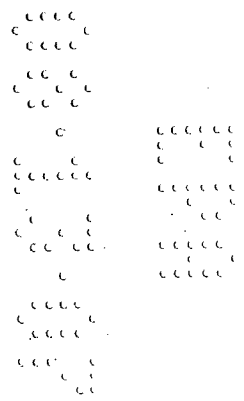

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE
Sanitizer for Swimming Pools

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **Precaution: Never add directly into pool as it will bleach the liner or painted surface.** Contact between product in undissolved state and vinyl liners, painted surfaces or other property in or around the pool will result in permanent bleaching of the color. Reentry into treated pools is prohibited above levels of 3 ppm due to risk of bodily injury.

1. Adjust water pH to 7.2 – 7.6 as determined by a test kit. For pools with copper plumbing best pH factor is 7.6 - 7.8.
2. If the pool has not been previously stabilized add conditioner and Stabilizer (cyanuric acid). Follow the directions for use on the label for that product.
3. Add 3 tablets for every 10,000 gallons of pool water. Each DAY-TAB weighs 65 grams. This should be adjusted to satisfy the demand of the water and establish chlorine residual. If there is no chlorine residual on the following day, repeat dosage until chlorine is found on following day before feeding at least the amount of 1.0 ppm to 1.5 ppm as determined by a test kit. During heat waves or periods of heavy bathing load, more tablets will be required to maintain chlorine residual. Also check pH to keep in proper range, as pH has a direct affect on chlorine action. These tablets reduce the need for addition of chemicals to adjust pH, but pH should be brought back into range if it falls or climbs due to rain, make up water, wind blown dust, or any reason. Add tablets through skimmer or in appropriate floating chlorinator. Tablets will dissolve in approximately 15 minutes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

Pesticide Storage: Store this product in a cool dry area, away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid deterioration.

Pesticide Disposal: In case of spill, flood areas with large quantities of water. Product or rinsates that cannot be used should be diluted with water before disposal in a sanitary sewer.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse empty container but place in trash collection.
