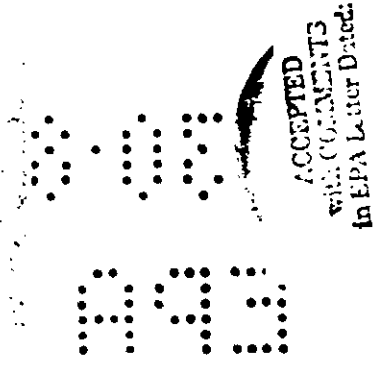

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is in violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is a clear emulsion useful for the protection of wood against fungus growths which cause rot and stain. It contains water repellents to aid in the control of shrinking, swelling, and checking grain raising and warping.

This product will extend the service life of wood several years beyond that of untreated wood. Actual benefit will depend upon the type of wood, its condition prior to treatment, the thoroughness of treatment, and the type of exposure received.

For best results, this product should be applied so as to effect maximum penetration into the wood and heavy absorption especially at joints wherever end grain exists. A 3-minute immersion period is recommended for millwork. For other open tank treatments, complete immersion of the wood in the solution is generally recommended for five minutes per inch of thickness. For the control of dimensional changes, shrinkage and swelling, the treatment of the end grain is most important since the moisture pick-up there is a hundred to a thousand times greater than at the flat or edge grain surface of many species of wood.

Where open tank treating is impractical, two heavy brush applications of this product should be applied, cutting out and removing all unsound wood two feet beyond any visible evidence of decay. All wood should be normally dry, and the framing or cutting completed before application of this product.

Estimated coverage: 8 to 10 gallons per thousand board feet for open tank treating; 200 square feet per gallon for brush application.

WOOD PRESERVATIVE USES

Protects the following types of wood: shingles, millwork, windows, doors, outside furniture, decks, spars, house siding, docks, piers, slats, staking material. Not intended for ground contact useage.

EXCESSIVE PRODUCT CLAIMS

Protects wood against mold, mildew, rot, wood rot fungi, mildew stain and attack by termites.

NOTE TO USER

- Do not apply over painted or varnished surfaces or bark.
- Do not use on wood intended for food, feed, potable water, livestock or dairy animal contact surfaces.
- May injure living plants during application.
- For exterior use only.

HAZARDS

FIRST AID: If swallowed, induce vomiting.

In case of eye contact, flush with water for 15 minutes and get medical attention. Wash with soap and water. Remove clothes before re-entry.

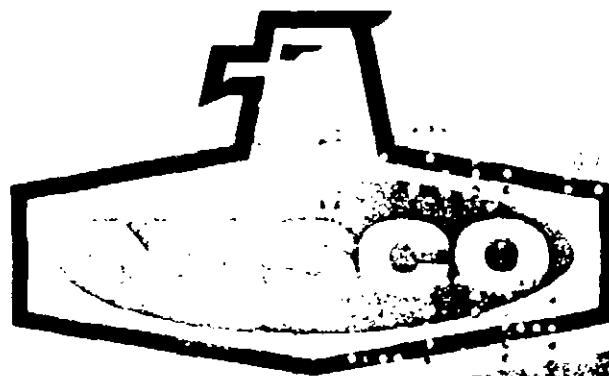
