

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. Prohibitions

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

WARNING: Keep out of the reach of children. Do not take internally. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR Part II. Avoid spraying food crops. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Keep container closed. Handle concentrate in a well-ventilated area.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine by injection is the preferable antidote. Oximes, such as 2-PAM, may or may not be therapeutic but are recommended they not be used in place of atropine.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and bees. Do not apply directly to water. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste. Shrimp and crab may be killed at application rates recommended on the label. Do not apply where these are important resources. Apply this product only as specified on the label.
