The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. On Left Panel under "WARNING" add the following sentence after "the skin."

"...because this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. Exposure during pregnancy should be avoided."

Also, underline the words "mild" and "severe."

- b. Delete the "Environmental Hazards" section.
- c. Delete "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" and "GENERAL CLASSIFICATION."
- d. Delete the "USE RESTRICTIONS" sentence.
- e. Delete "Mixing Instructions." The following would be acceptable as a sentence after "their registrations":

"Registered bait...to formulators on request."



- f. Move "Do Not Reuse Empty Container" as a first sentence after the heading "Container Disposal."
 - g. Change "foodstuffs" to "food and feed."
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
