DANGER

Exposure during pregnancy should be avoided. Fatal if swallowed, absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not inhale powder. When mixing or handling, wear dust respirator, eye goggles, or face shield and rubber gloves. Wash arms and face with soap and water after mixing or handling and before eating or smoking.

Repeated exposure to small amounts of this product can produce accumulative toxicity. Persons at risk should have their prothrombin times checked periodically.

Note To Physician: If swallowed, absorbed or inhaled by humans, domestic animals or pets, this material will reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. In such cases, treat as in bishydroxycoumarin overdoses, giving vitamin K₁ intramuscularly in mild cases and giving vitamin K₃ intravenously and blood transfusions in severe cases. Repeat as necessary based on monitoring of prothrombin times.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge.
