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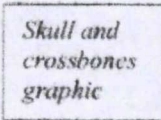

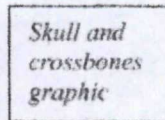

### FIRST AID

For humans that have ingested this product, or have obvious poisoning symptoms (bleeding) or prolonged prothrombin times, give Vitamin K<sub>1</sub> by intramuscular or oral administration. In severe cases, blood transfusions may be necessary. Check prothrombin time every 3 days until values return to normal.
