Under SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS, the last sentence should read "Remove as much alternative food as possible." You have deleted the word 'alternative'.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

The Agency does not accept your request for a three-month extension for submission of data to support the weatherability claim for this product as required in our letter of September 17, 1991. The need for this data was brought to the attention of Lipha Chemicals in an Agency letter dated June 8, 1984, and we believe that the specified nine months is a sufficient amount of time to generate the data if you desire to support the claims for this product.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is to be used in a manner inconsistent with the label.

**READ THIS LABEL:** Read and follow all directions and use precautions.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not expose animals to rodenticides. To help protect children and pets:

1. Store product not in use in a locked container.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of animals and nontarget wildlife, children under six years of age, and pets. These stations must be resistant to tampering. This prevents such children from reaching bait. If a bait can be shifted, units must be secured with tamper-resistant caps. Stronger bait stations are needed in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container, bait as specified on this label.

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** For control of house mice in and around human-made structures. Do not use in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food. Do not broadcast.

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT:** Where rats and or mice will most likely be found. Generally, these are along walls, in burrows, in corners and concealed areas, or in locations where rodents are likely to be found. Protect bait from rain or snow.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:**  
**RATS:** Apply 4 to 16 ounces of bait in an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait.  
**MICE:** Apply 1/4 to 1/2 oz. (1-2 stations) at 12-foot intervals. Larger placements are needed in areas where there is a supply of fresh bait for at least 1 week.  
**RATS/MICE:** Replace bait containers as needed. Collect and dispose of all dead rodents. To prevent reinfestation, limit rodent harborage as much as possible. Repeat treatment. Where a continuous supply of bait is needed, establish permanent bait stations.
