Under SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS, the last sentence should read "Remove as much alternative food as possible." You have deleted the word 'alternative'.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

The Agency does not accept your request for a three-month extension for submission of data to support the weatherability claim for this product as required by our letter of September 17, 1991. The need for this data was brought to the attention of Lipha Chemicals in an Agency letter dated August 27, 1987, and we believe that the specified nine months is a sufficient amount of time to generate the data if you desire to support the claims for this product.
