Resubmission of Amended Labeling Dated June 14, 1995

Dear Mr. Marshall,

We have reviewed the labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, and pursuant to PR Notice 94-7. The subject amended labeling is acceptable provided that you:

1. Modify the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" section on the outer package label so that the entire paragraphs entitled "URBAN AREAS" and "NONURBAN AREAS" are indented at least two spaces so that it is clear to the reader that the headings of these paragraphs are subordinate to "USE RESTRICTIONS" and that the final paragraph of this section, which pertains to placement of bait, applies to all permissible urban and nonurban uses of this product.

2. Change the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" statement on both the outer package label and individual placepack labels to read

"This product is toxic to mammals and birds. Do not apply this product directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark."

3. Amend the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" statement on both the outer package label and individual placepack labels as indicated below.

a. If your product is intended for both commercial and household uses, change the "PESTICIDE DISPOSAL" and "CONTAINER DISPOSAL" directions to read

"PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

"CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Commercial use: Dispose of empty container in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.



4. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling for both the outer package and individual placepacks before you release the product for shipment. We caution you to refrain from adding any claims or directions to the final printed label that were not part of the stamped accepted label.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT:

Determine areas where rats and mice are likely to consume the bait. General openings, in or beside burrows, between floors and walls, or signs have been seen. Repeat treatment if necessary.

APPLICATION DIRECTION:

RATS: Apply 3 to 10 packs per placement. Space bait placements 15 feet apart. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days. **MICE:** Open the pack and place 1 to 2 packs per typical placement. Repeat bait placements at intervals of 15 days. **RATS AND MICE:** Repeat treatment if necessary. Collect and dispose of leftover bait, and any bait that has been consumed by animals. To prevent reinfestation, water, and herbivore signs must be eliminated. If necessary, repeat treatment. If necessary, establish permanent bait stations.
