

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

WARNING

May be fatal if swallowed, absorbed through the skin, or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not inhale powder. When mixing baits, wear dust respirator, eye goggles and rubber gloves. Wash arms, hands, and face with soap and water after mixing or handling and before eating and smoking. 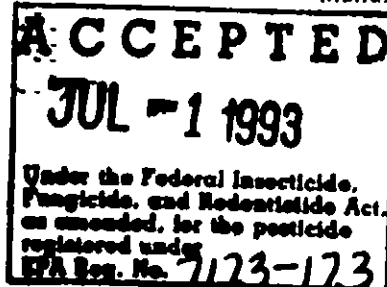
