Purpose

This submission proposes to revise the label for this product, under sec 3 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), to add the phrase, "For the Control of Pocket Gophers Only." on the Front Panel to prevent this product from being used to control other species, such as prairie dogs.

Labeling

The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product.

- 1. Under "WARRANTY", add the following text at the beginning of this section: "To the extent consistent with applicable law, ..."
- 2. Increase the type size of the minimum type from 5 to 6 points and the distance between letters so that the text is easily read by users and viewed in our Pesticide Product Label System (PPLS). We have increased the version that we received to resolve this problem partially. See Attachment 2.



Repeated doss may be needed for up to 30 days (based on monitoring of prothrombin times). It may be necessary to check prothrombin times every 3 days until values return to normal. Office from for placing Rozol Pocket Gopher Balt for Pocket Gopher control: Burrowing pocket gophers (Thomomys sp. and Geomys sp.) throw out low, fan-shaped mounds on either side of their underground throw out low, lan-shaped mounds on extres side of new underground unnel. These lateral lunnels coming to the surface are on the flat side of the lan and these holes plugged with lose soil.

Treatment: Can be made in one or both of the following ways.

With a long-handled tablespoon, carefully remove the plug on the flat side of the fam. Carefully insert 1/2 cup of balt as far down into the hole as possible. Reclose opening, being careful not to cover the balk with soil.


2. Using a metal rod, probe 6-12 inches deep to locate the main turnel.

Consult diagram below for location to probe. Drop 1/2 cup of ball into the turnel and cover the hole so light will not enter the turnel system.

Make 2-3 treatments per burrow system. Bury dead animals and spilled ball found on soil surface immediately using gloves. Maintain a constant supply of ball in the burrow system for as long as there is gopher activity. Do not apply bait on surface of soil.



The right and the wrong ways to use a probe for poisoning gophers are shown above. Be sure that bas is in the main runway - not in the laterals or imbedded in the bottom of the runway.
