Treated baits must be placed in tamper-proof bait boxes or in locations not accessible to children, pets, domestic animals or wildlife. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS — Determine areas where rats and/or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been observed. Protect bait from rain or snow.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

RATS: Apply 4 to 10 ounces of bait to infestation sites. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.

MICE: Apply 1/4 to 1/2 ounce (1-2 level tablespoons) of bait at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.

RATS & MICE: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and unconsumed bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, eliminate food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL. OPEN BURNING AND DUMPING IS PROHIBITED. DO NOT REUSE EMPTY CONTAINER.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL. Pesticide that cannot be used, should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place, away from water supplies.

CONTAINER-DISPOSAL. Dispose of in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticides containers or bury in a safe place. Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.
