Dear Mr. Marshall,

We have reviewed the labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, and pursuant to PR Notice 94-7. The subject amended labeling is acceptable provided that you:


1. Modify the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" section so that the entire paragraphs entitled "URBAN AREAS" and "NONURBAN AREAS" are indented at least two spaces so that it is clear to the reader that the headings of these paragraphs are subordinate to "USE RESTRICTIONS" and that the final paragraph of this section, which pertains to placement of bait, applies to all permissible urban and nonurban uses of this product.
2. Change the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" statement to read
"This product is toxic to mammals and birds. Do not apply this product directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark."
3. Amend the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" statement, specifically the "PESTICIDE DISPOSAL" directions, to read
"PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product should be securely wrapped in several layers of newspaper and then disposed of onsite or at an approved waste disposal facility."
4. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. We caution you to refrain from adding any claims or directions to the final printed label that were not ~~part of the~~ ~~initial~~ ~~stamped~~ ~~accepted~~ label.

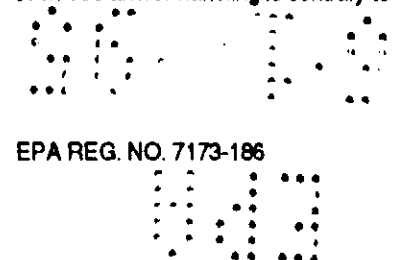

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL: Read this label and use precautions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose domestic animals to rodenticides. To help protect animals:

1. Store product not in use in a locked container.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in areas inaccessible to children under six years of age, and in areas where raccoons, bears, or other potential vandals are not present. Stronger bait stations are needed in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container, used or unused, as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS:

For control of Norway Rats, Roof Rats, and House Mice in URBAN AREAS: This product may be used in and around related structures (e.g., aircraft) and in alleys.

NON URBAN AREAS: This product may be used in homes and agricultural buildings.

Do not place bait in areas where it may contaminate food or surfaces of food. Do not broadcast bait.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:

Determine areas where rats and mice are likely to consume the bait. Generally, these areas are in openings, in or beside burrows, in cracks and crevices, between floors and walls, or in areas where signs have been seen. Remove signs if possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

RATS: Apply 4 to 16 ounces of bait per placement. Space bait placements 15 to 30 feet apart. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of bait until fresh signs of rat activity cease to appear. **MICE:** Apply 1/4 - 1/2 ounces (1 to 2 placements) at typical placement. Larger placements may be used at points of extremely high mouse activity. Maintain bait for 15 days or until fresh signs of mouse activity are seen. **RATS AND MICE:** Replace bait immediately. Collect and properly dispose of leftover bait, and any bait that has been consumed by animals. To prevent reinfestation, clean up water, and harborage as much as possible. Where activity is present, establish permanent bait stations if needed.
