**IMPORTANT:** Do not expose children, pets or other nontarget animals to rodenticides.

To help prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six (6) years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hooved livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container, unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

**USE RESTRICTIONS:**

For control of Norway Rats, Roof Rats and House Mice.

Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait.

**Urban Areas:** This product may be used in and around the periphery of homes, industrial, commercial, and public buildings. This product may also be used in transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft) and in related port or terminal buildings. This product may also be used in alleys.

**Non Urban Areas:** May be used inside of homes and agricultural buildings.

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:**

Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:**

**RATS:** Apply 4 to 16 ounces of bait per placement. Placements usually should be spaced at intervals of 15 to 30 feet. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

**MICE:** Apply 1/4 to 1/2 ounce of bait per placement. Space placements at 8- to 12-foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 ounces) may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.

**RATS and MICE:** Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.

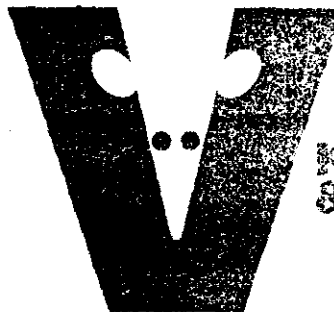

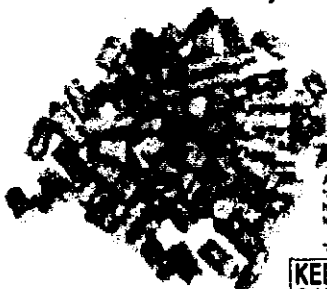
