Subject: Addition of Packaging Sizes on Labeling Maki Rat and Mouse Bait Packs (Pellets) EPA Registration No. 7173-188 Your Submission Dated March 5, 2001

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- 1. For both the outer container and place pack labels, change the modified singlefeeding claim as follows: "Norway rats and house mice may consume a lethal dose in one night's feeding with first dead rodents appearing four or five days after feeding begins."
- 2. In the second sentence of the "Urban areas:" paragraph, change "in and around transport vehicles" to "in transport vehicles."
- 3. In the third sentence of the "Rats and Mice:" paragraph, change "To prevent reinfestation" to "To discourage reinfestation."
- 4. Insert the following as the second sentence of the "Application Directions" for "Rats:": "Space placements at intervals of 15 to 30 feet in infested areas."

Outer Container Label

Rats: Place at least 3 to 10 packs per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease. Mice: Use one pack per bait placement. Space placements at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease. Rats and Mice: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, eliminate food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.
